DISCUSSION GUIDE

- 1. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. How does believing the Bible is "inspired/God-breathed" change the way you read or apply it in daily life?
- 2. What does it mean for you to treat the Bible as authoritative in a world with competing voices (e.g., media, culture, other religions)?
- 3. A worldview is the set of beliefs, values, and assumptions through which a person interprets reality, answering fundamental questions about God, humanity, purpose, and morality. How has the Bible shaped your worldview?
- 4. What is one area (e.g., relationships, work, sex) where you struggle to follow the teachings and worldview of the Bible over other influences?
- 5. The Bible teaches that humans are created in God's image (*imago Dei*), designed for relationship with Him, others, and creation (Gen 1:26-27), yet fallen due to sin, resulting in a broken, rebellious nature (Rom 3:23). Do you struggle to embrace this view of what it means to be human?
- 6. Share a time when a Bible verse guided a decision or action (e.g., forgiving someone, making a tough choice).
- 7. What happens to you when you make reading the Bible a daily practice? (Read Romans 12:2 for one idea)
- 8. Read Matthew 4:4. How can you make reading the Bible a daily habit?

PRAYER EXERCISE

Have each group member choose a favorite verse or one from the discussion. Go around the circle, with each person praying a one-sentence prayer of gratitude, e.g., "God, thank You for inspiring Psalm 23 to comfort me in tough times."

Close with a leader praying for ongoing engagement with Scripture.
