SERMON SUMMARY

Today's movie reminds us that God gives us His power to take risks, dream big and pursue excellence. We can glorify Him as we team with other followers of Jesus to do great things.

KEY VERSES

John 1:42

1 Corinthians 12:12-27

1. Being Seen by God

Scripture: Genesis 16:7-13 (Hagar and "El Roi")

- Just as Sonny saw something in Michael Jordan others missed, God saw Hagar in her pain and isolation.
Question: When have you felt overlooked or invisible, and how did God (or others) remind you of your worth?

2. Jesus Sees Our Potential

Scripture: John 1:42 (Jesus renames Simon as Peter); John 4:4-26 (the woman at the well)

- Jesus consistently saw people not just as they were, but as who they could become.
Question: How does it change the way you see yourself—and others—knowing that Jesus sees your potential beyond your present circumstances?

3. Faith and Risk

Scripture: Matthew 14:28-31 (Peter walking on water); Hebrews 11:8 (Abraham steps out in faith)

- Sonny risked everything on an untested rookie; faith often calls us into risky trust.
Question: What risk of faith might God be calling you to take right now, and what makes it hard to step out?

4. The Power of Teamwork

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 (The body of Christ)

- Nike's success wasn't just Sonny—it took a whole team working together.
Question: What role do you play in the "body of Christ," and how can your gifts strengthen the team around you?

5. Living with Excellence

Scripture: Colossians 3:23-24 ("Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord")

- Jordan's excellence inspired others; our excellence in daily life can honor God.
Question: How can you bring excellence into your work, home, or relationships this week—not to impress others, but to reflect God's goodness?

CLOSING PRAYER

Heavenly Father,
thank You that You are the God who sees us—our struggles, our hopes, and the potential You've placed within us. Thank You for reminding us that our worth is not in what others say about us, but in who You say we are.

Lord, give us courage to take risks of faith, trusting that You are with us when we step out of the boat.
