1. What is a LifeGroup?

A Creekside LifeGroup is a small group Bible study, a gathering of a few people (typically 6–12), who meet regularly to study the Bible, discuss life, and grow in their faith together. It's informal and encourages conversation, prayer, and mutual support.

2. Who can join a small group Bible study?

Anyone is welcome—whether you're new to faith, a long-time believer, or just curious about the Bible.

3. Do I need to be a Bible expert to join?

No prior knowledge is required. Our LifeGroup studies are designed to be accessible to everyone, regardless of biblical background. You'll learn and grow together with others.

4. What happens during a typical meeting?

A typical meeting includes:

- Prayer
- A short video based on Creekside's teaching series, “ “
- Discussion/questions and Bible reading
- Sharing life experiences
- Encouragement and prayer requests

Meetings usually last 90 - 120 minutes.

5. How often will we meet?

Most LifeGroups will meet weekly for our six-week series.
