

Invitation Scripts

Steps:

1. Write a list of 10 names of friends and family to invite.
2. Plan a day and time (90 minutes to 2 hours) that will work for you to meet for group.
3. About 3 weeks before your planned start date, send out your invitations!
4. Check out the FAQs page for answers to common questions your invitees may ask.
